

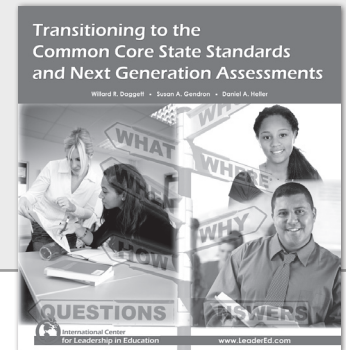
# Transitioning to the Common Core State Standards and Next Generation Assessments


