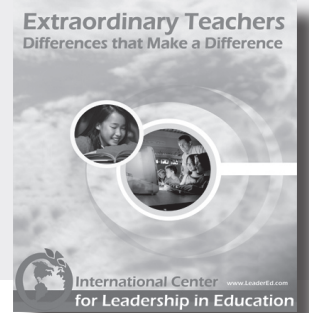


# Extraordinary Teachers — Differences that Make a Difference

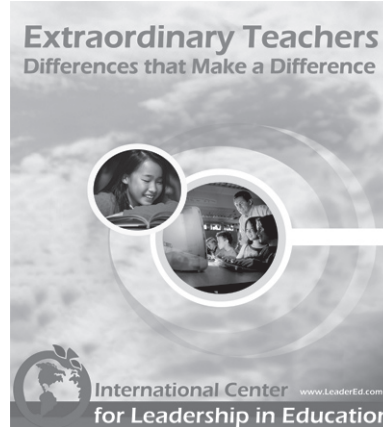
